

Proverbs 6:16-19 7 More things God Hates:	Contrast these with other things we've looked at before:
1. haughty eyes	Psalm 19:8b - The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes
2. a lying tongue	Psalm 19:14 - Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart Be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD
3. hands that shed innocent blood	Psalm 24: 3-4 - Who shall go up into the hill of the LORD? Or who shall stand in His holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul to vanity, and has not sworn deceitfully.
4. a heart that devises wicked plans	He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation.
5. feet that hurry to run to evil	Romans 10:15 And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!"
6. a lying witness who testifies falsely.	James 3:18 And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.
7. one who sows discord in a family.

This is a list showing a natural progression on to the very worst of the list:

1. haughty eyes - not enlightened ones, know too much to think they need God or His laws;
2. a lying tongue - having rejected God's truth, nothing left but lies
3. hands that shed innocent blood - when you stop caring about God, you will stop caring about others - not care when they get hurt. - "words cut like a knife"
4. heart will begin to enjoy it - might have been accidental or unintentional at first, but later you look forward to it.
5. and then your feet hurry to carry out the wicked plans.

Get enough people doing this and the whole society breaks down; because:

6. Two foundations of society are 1) personal integrity and honor or morality - lying witness undermines all this

and 7)

2) the family - basis of every relationship with everyone else - where you learn about love and how to treat others - destroy the family and you destroy the whole society.

church family - Romans 12:18 as far as it depends on you, live peaceably.

How far does it depend? What are you responsible for?

Can't control: what others do, say, or how they react.

You are responsible for how you react to them.
 You are responsible for how you make them potentially react.
 You are responsible for what you choose to overlook: "Eyes that do not see and ears that do not hear" was one Christlike quality.

Is it good, necessary, uplifting, constructive?
 or is it coming from a haughty eye, a lying tongue, an attempt to shed innocent blood or even not-so-innocent blood, are you in a hurry to say or do it, and does it sow discord.
